3. Will your videos be enough for CUET PG / IIT-JAM Economics Exam? Or, Will I have to read books also?

Ans: Your goal should NOT be only clearing the CUET PG / IIT JAM Economics Exam. Let us elaborate on this.

In earlier years (before CUET PG Exam was introduced), each University / College used to conduct their separate exam for admission into MA Economics programme. For instance, DSE's entrance exam was considered more mathematical, compared to many other entrance exams. Hence, only candidates who were somewhat comfortable with mathematical aspects entered DSE. Still, seeing ERs (Essential Repeats) were common at DSE and many candidates couldn't even complete their Master's degree.

Even in other Universities, candidates who did not have conceptual clarity suffered, though to a lower extent.

Now, admission into Master's programme at most prominent Universities (including DSE) happens through CUET PG Economics exam. At least in recent years, the CUET PG Economics exam has been less mathematical and has focused more on factual type questions. However, the Master's degree curriculum has remained the same at DSE (and other Universities).

In short, your focus should be on building good concepts that help you in: Clearing the MA Economics Entrance Exams, performing well in Master's programme and wherever you need Economics in life ahead.

4. How should I utilise this Full-Course to build good concepts and clear the CUET PG Economics entrance exam?

- 1. Watch the videos and understand the concept. Conceptual Clarity that you build at this stage will help you forever in life, be it for Economics related recruitment exams (viz., Indian Economic Service, RBI DEPR Exam, etc.) or pursuing a career in Economic Research or in Corporate jobs (viz., Analytics and Data Science roles)
- 2. Makes hand-written notes for multiple rounds of Revision: Use the content given in videos to make notes. This step is crucial. Remember, in the final CUET PG / IIT-JAM Economics exam, you will be able to perform well only if you remember all topics well. This requires multiple rounds of revision. If you do not revise multiple times, your retention will be poor and you will NOT be able to do your best in the exam.
- If you do not make self-written notes, revising will be difficult at the later stage. Hence, focus on building quality notes from initial days itself.
- **3. Maintain separate notebooks** for different subject combinations. For instance, one notebook for Statistics and Econometrics, one for Macroeconomics + International Economics + Development Economics, etc.
- **4. Read Books:** For each class, we mention the reading (reference Chapter and Books). We encourage you to read. This will improve your confidence.
- **5.** We reiterate, revise consistently: When you read a topic for the first time, you may forget it after 2 days only. If you revise it, your retention will last longer (maybe 5-6 days). If you revise it again after a few days, your retention will improve even further.

You should target, at least, 5-6 rounds of revision of entire syllabus before the final exam. If you do that, you will feel very comfortable in the exam.

5. Will videos be separate for CUET PG and IIT-JAM Economics Exam? That is, if I want to cover only CUET PG Economics exam, can I just watch the videos of CUET PG Economics Exam?

Ans: No. We sincerely believe that it would NOT be a good approach. Preparation will be common for the two exams; only practice will be different. At practice stage (through Test Series), we will practice questions similar to those that have been asked in these exams in the recent years.

6. I am enrolled in Full-Course. Do I have to pay separately for Test Series?

Ans: No. For candidates enrolled in the Full-Course, Test Series is a part of the package.

7. Can you provide details of Test Series? As in, how many Mock Tests and Questions it contains?

8. Will Testonomics provide any pdf notes?

Ans: No. You will have to prepare hand-written notes. Watch the videos and then use the video content and /or recommended readings to prepare your own notes.

9. What about doubt support? In live classes, we could get our doubts resolved there and then. How will this work-out in pre-recorded courses?

Based on my 12 years of schooling, 3 years of under-graduation and 2 years of postgraduation, I can say with confidence that less than 10% of candidates manage to ask doubts in live classes and the remaining 90% never ask any doubt!

Perhaps because of mere hesitation. Perhaps because, they feel they need to revise the previous class first and only then they will be able to understand today's class.

In our pre-recorded classes, addressing doubts is far more convenient:

- First, we try that you don't get any doubt. That is, we try to produce well-explained videos.
- Second, if you get any doubt, you can send us over WhatsApp. We will reply as soon as possible (usually within 2-3 days) and make sure that the doubt is addressed.
- If we feel that you need to read something else first before understanding this concept, we will tell you to read that topic first
